

Year 8 Indonesian Project

"Sekolah Saya"

Task:

Your task is to create a class movie/documentary in Indonesian that shows a typical school week for a student in Year 8. This documentary will be put together and burnt to DVD to send to our sister school in Yogyakarta so it can be used as a resource when learning about our education system and daily life of teenagers in Australia.



Why?

To show the students from our sister school in Indonesia whose language you are learning something about your life at your school. You are to prepare the entire documentary in their language, so that your culture can be shared with them.

OUTLINE OF THE TASK

You will be working in groups of three – four. Each group will choose one day of the week to cover in their part of the documentary. Your group's task is to:

1. Create a design brief (plan / description) of what you are going to cover in your day. In other words you will need to write down what you do in a typical day and how you intend to display this in the documentary. You will need to decide as a group who will feature in the documentary, what you will film on the day you have selected and who will be operating the video camera.
2. Prepare a script in Indonesian. As a group you will need to write out what you will say in the documentary based on the brief. You will be required to speak in Indonesian and have Indonesian sub titles. Also you can produce another copy of the documentary with English subtitles.
3. Once you have completed your brief and script you will be allocated a video camera to use on the specific day you have chosen. You will be responsible for

the camera and for the filming on the day. You will not be given a second day to film so make sure that you complete all your filming on the day. Remember that you can edit as you are producing the documentary so you can film quite a bit of footage and not use it all.

4. Once all groups have completed their filming we will be booked into a computer room for a week where your group will be able to edit and produce their section of the documentary.
5. A rubric will be distributed to your group that will give you an indication of the standard that you should be working on designing your section of the documentary, the Indonesian language used, the production of the documentary and how you work as a group

* Make sure that you use your class time effectively as time will be short and the final copy of the documentary will need to be completed by the end of the fourth week of term.
