Jodi spoke with Mark Sullivan's Year 11 Business Management class. The class is currently studying internal and external business factors and how they can affect a business. Jodi was able to impart her knowledge in this area and how a business may be affected by such things as values, management styles and employees. She was also able to explain this relative to her role and specifically in relation to real estate. Hearing this first hand from someone working in the field really resonated with students as they could connect their studies with real life situations.
