# The same in 2026 - learning structure

- 6 periods of learning each day (some doubles, some singles)
  - Subjects offered in each year level (including Elev8 and Phoenix)
  - Instructional model for all classes
    - Engage
    - Explore
    - Evaluate
  - Learning Intentions
  - Success Criteria
  - Behaviour expectations

# The same in 2026 - home rooms\*

    - Yes - the school day starts at 9am!
  - Setting up for a successful day of learning
  - Big Life program (in year levels) once a fortnight on Fridays
  - Year Level assembly\* on alternating Fridays

- EAL team will support students for whom English is not their primary language

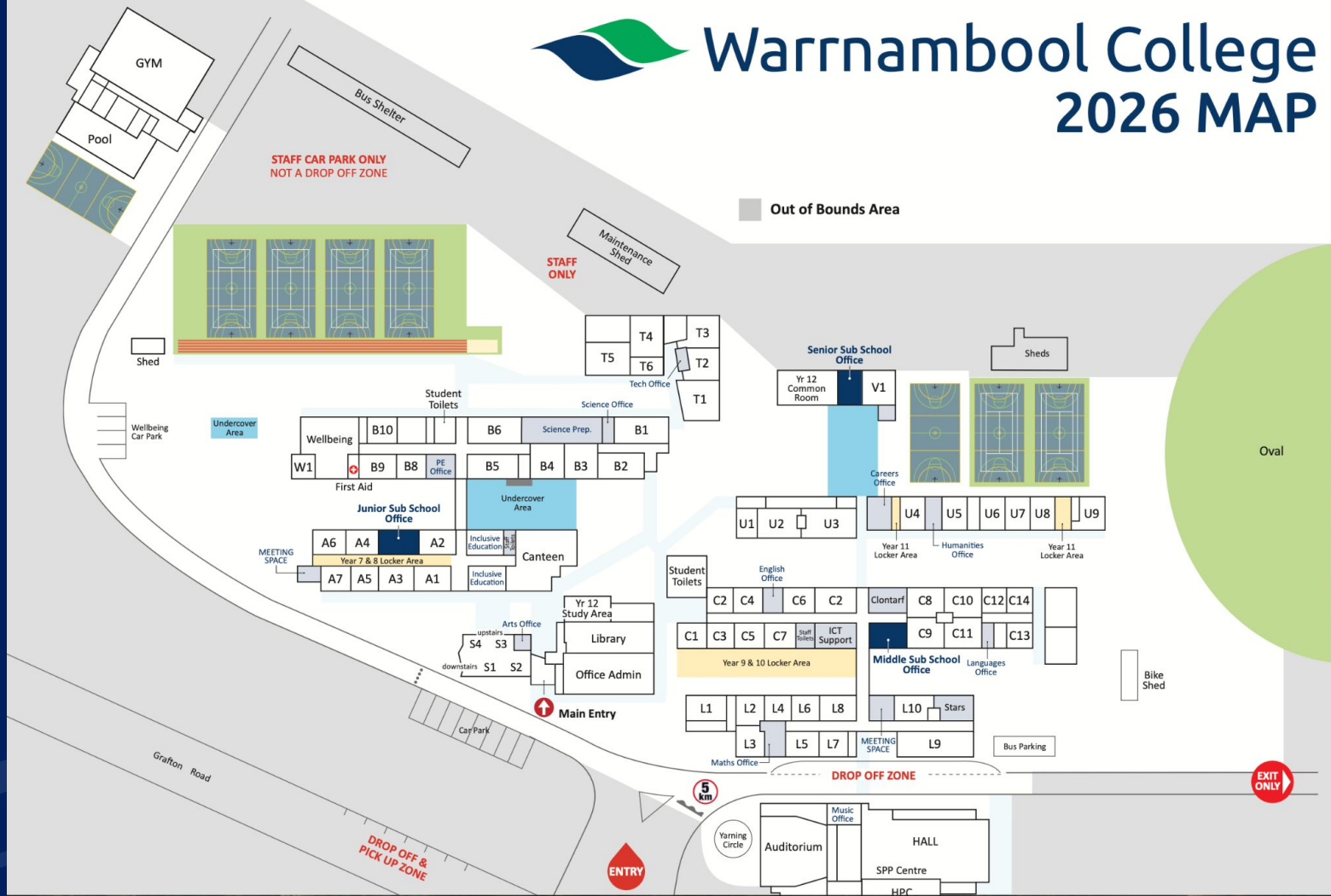

# Different in 2026 - lockers

- Year 7s: A wing  
(current Hopkins locker area)
- Year 8s: A wing  
(current Merri locker area)
- Year 9s: Outside C wing  
(current Belfast / Logans locker area)
- Year 10s: Outside C wing  
(current Belfast / Logans locker area)
- Year 11s: U wing  
(current Flagstaff locker area)
- Specific locker areas around the school and in Inclusive Ed Hub for students needing quieter spaces

# Different in 2026 - student leadership

- No house captains (or year level captains)
- Year level based student leaders will work together in sub-schools
  - Junior (7&8)
  - Middle (9&10)
  - Senior (11&12)
- College captains are separate to the sub-school student leadership teams

# Different in 2026 - house system

- No house leaders or specific house support staff
- No house offices
- No house assemblies
- Reduced number of house cups (to be decided next year)
- Philanthropic charities supported by sub-schools
  - Junior: Coastcare / Landcare
  - Middle: Western District Foodshare
  - Senior: Gillin Boys

# Different in 2026 - sub-schools

- Three sub-schools across WC
  - Junior: year 7 & 8
  - Middle: year 9 & 10
  - Senior: year 11 & 12
- Each year level will have these support staff based in their sub-school office:
  - Year Level Leader
  - Year Level Manager
  - Sub-School Assistant

# Different in 2026 - assembly locations

- Year 7s: A wing
- Year 8s: B wing
- Year 9s: C wing
- Year 10s: L wing
- Year 11s: Hall
- Year 12s: Auditorium

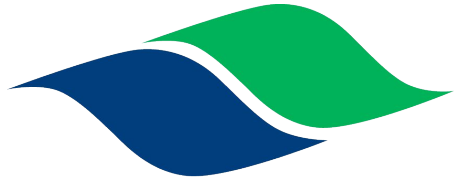
# Different in 2026 - home rooms

- Home rooms will be allocated within a year level / same age groups
- Years 7-9 homerooms will be same grouping as core classes
- Home room mentor will hopefully be a significant teacher for home room students
- Year 10 and VCE homerooms will be randomly assigned
- VCE VM students will be in different home rooms to VCE students (year 11&12)
- Locations:
  - Year 7: A wing
  - Year 8: B wing
  - Year 9: C wing (2025 Logans rooms)
  - Year 10: L wing
  - Year 11: U wing
  - Year 12: C wing (2025 Merri rooms)
